WELL INOPERATIVE/LOSS OF ELECTICITY

- 1. Notify Norris Public Power Emergency (402) 223-4087
- 2. Notify staff and residents (water conservation notice)
- 3. Monitor situation continuously
- 4. If water pressure drops below 20 psi in more than 10% of the system contact State field rep (Andy Kahle) (402) 440-4917

WELLS CONTAMINATED

- 1. Notify staff and residents of the contamination and the procedures that need to be followed for their protection
- 2. Notify State Field Rep. (Andy Kahle) (402) 471-0521
- 3. Notify Nebraska Rural Water Assn. (Randy Hellbusch, Pat Petersen, Mike Stanzel, Barney Whatley) (800) 842-8039
- 4. Take water samples to ensure water is safe for consumption
- 5. Take corrective action to fix the problem

BREECH OF SECURITY

- 1. Contact Local Law Enforcement
- 2. Contact State Field Representative
- 3. Notify FBI (Local Law Enforcement to make call)
- 4. Notify system owner
- 5. Contact NeRWA for assistance
- 6. Isolate affected system component if necessary (use alternate well, isolate tower, etc.)
- 7. Determine if system has been tampered with. (sanitary seal still intact, vent screens still in place, anything broken or disturbed, etc.)
- 8. Follow primacy agency's instructions or recommendations
- 9. Notify staff and residents if necessary
- 10. Secure alternate drinking water source if necessary
- 11. Sample as instructed by primacy agency
- 12. Notify local health officials

LOSS OF WATER STORAGE

- 1. Notify State Field Rep. (Andy Kahle) (402) 471-0521
- 2. Isolate water storage from system
- 3. Open bypass valves to well
- 4. Contact Nebraska Rural Water Assn. (800) 842-8039
- 5. Notify staff and residents of the situation and keep them informed

EXPLOSION

- 1. Notify Hickman Volunteer Fire Department
- 2. Notify Civil Defense and Lancaster Co. Sheriff Dept.
- 3. Insure that the water system is unaffected
- 4. If water system is affected, notify State Field Rep. (Andy Kahle) (402) 471-0521 and NeRWA (800) 842-8039

FLOOD

- 1. Ensure wells are diked for protection
- 2. Inform local civil defense director of the situation
- 3. Inform Gage County Sheriffs office
- 4. Inform State Field Rep. (Andy Kahle) (402) 440-4917
- 5. Inform staff and residents and keep them informed
- 6. Inform NeRWA and ask for assistance if needed
